The 1st ranked teams (A1 and B1) advance directly to the semi-finals, while A2 will play B3 and A3 will play B2 to determine the last teams in the semi-finals.

For the semi-finals, if there are two teams from each group then A1 plays the B qualifier and B1 plays the A qualifier; if there are three teams from the same group, the top ranked team from that group plays the lowest ranked team from the same group.
